

Anver M. Emon is Professor and Canada Research Chair in Religion, Pluralism, and the Rule of Law, University of Toronto, where he teaches and researches in the areas of Islamic law and legal theory, statutory interpretation, and Common Law Torts. He is an internationally recognized scholar of Islamic law, having published widely in the field. He is the editor in chief of *Middle East Law and Governance*, a peer reviewed journal, and a general editor of the *Oxford Islamic Legal Studies Series*. In addition to his academic work, he regularly consults with government agencies and NGOs on issues of law, governance, and development in legally pluralist countries.

Matthew Levering has recently been appointed to a newly formed chair at Mundelein Seminary. Before coming to Mundelein, he taught at the University of Dayton and Ave Maria University. He is the author or editor of more than thirty books in the fields of Catholic theology and Aquinas studies including *Biblical Natural Law*.
